What does this mean for you?

As mentioned above, the provision of courses will continue unaffected and uninterrupted. There will be no changes to your lecturers or to any of the administrative arrangements already in place. Over time we hope that you will notice some positive improvements to the campus, learning resources and support services available to students.

Any student enrolled with the Southern School of Natural Therapies Limited on 12 March 2010 will be automatically transferred to Think: Colleges Pty Ltd trading as Southern School of Natural Therapies.

Options

1. **If you are happy to automatically transfer your enrolment, you do not have to respond.** Your enrolment will be automatically transferred to Think: Colleges Pty Ltd trading as Southern School of Natural Therapies on 12 March 2010.
2. Should you not wish to automatically transfer your enrolment, you can:

Choose to transfer to a comparable course in another institution. You must be aware that this course of action will possibly delay the completion of your studies;

Or

Withdraw from SSNT and seek a refund of any tuition fees already paid to Southern School of Natural Therapies for the 2010 academic year. In this case, you will need to complete a Withdrawal Form and return this to Student Services.

In either case, you need to advise us by no later than 12 March 2010.
